

Dear Wazi Family,

Here is a checklist of very important information you need to follow before camp starts. Please make sure that you have checked ALL boxes. Please print this form so you will have the checklist to use. We're looking forward to a fantastic summer!

CAMP WAZIYATAH CHECKLIST FOR SUMMER 2010

Medical Form and immunization report - The Health Care Recommendations Form - must be printed, signed by a doctor, and faxed to 509-357-2267. Make sure the camper's name is written clearly. You MUST have this form signed by a doctor and sent in for your child to attend camp. The form can be found in our online registration system and becomes available to download upon logging out of the system. Your doctor's office will provide or fax your camper's immunization report, which you can fax in to us with the medical form. You can also scan and email both forms to Natalia@wazi.com

Clothing labeled with camper name. Please see the packing list on our website under the parents section for more info on what to bring.

Registration complete with age and grade correct online. Some people have been confused regarding the rising grade to enter online. The rising grade is the grade your child will be entering in the Fall AFTER camp. This is very important for housing your camper in the correct cabin. Please complete all information in our registration system including tee-shirt size and upload a clear camper photograph with only your child in the picture.

Baggage packed and ready for camp:

1. Campers flying to camp must ship their bags to arrive at camp by June 18, 2010 using one of two options below. Only international campers can bring baggage on the plane.
 - a. Camp Baggage If your camper is flying to camp from the states of MA, RI, CT, NY, NJ, PA, DE, MD, DC and south FL, this is a required service. SIGN UP NOW SO YOU DON'T MISS PICKUPS! You can sign up online at campbaggage.com, or use the form available by download from our online registration system (upon logging out). Two week campers can send baggage to camp with Camp Baggage (they conveniently pick up at your home) and return it home via pre-paid FedEx or wait two weeks for the 4 week return from Camp Baggage.
 - b. Send via FedEx ground service or UPS.
2. Drop-offs at camp do not need to ship baggage.
3. Boston area campers using the Boston bus can bring their baggage with them to the bus at Logan Airport or the Newton pickup location at the green line Riverside T station and it will travel with them on the bus.

Travel information including flight info entered into our online registration system. Click on transportation, select your travel options - bus to and from Boston or Portland airports or drop-off, and click "flight info" (the small airplane icon) to add flight arrival time and flight number. This information must be entered so we know where to pick up your camper.

Payment complete. All balances are due by June 1st, so you must be paid in full.

Camp logo items & Camp clothes. Our new camp apparel provider is Cloz.com. A link will be on our web site, or go to <http://www.cloz.com/Cloz.aspx?OrgID=2040>

Whitewater rafting. If your child has chosen to go on one of our whitewater rafting trips (must be 10 years old or older to attend), you must download, sign and fax the release form to us at 509-357-2267. The form is available in our online registration system, and will appear for download upon signing out. Your child cannot attend unless we have a signed form. Please make sure names are written clearly, and your waiver is sent in before June 1.

Camp store payment entered. We suggest \$100 for purchases and incidentals like a new toothbrush or shipping for a left-behind item. We allow campers to purchase items at camp like tee-shirts and hoodies. Food is not offered at the camp store. All remaining amounts will be donated to the camp improvement fund or refunded back to your credit card after camp.

Lice Disclaimer - Children must be checked for lice and nits within three days of the beginning of the camp session and the agreement to our online lice disclaimer must be checked. The disclaimer is a required checkbox found in our camp registration system in the medical section. The disclaimer checkbox will appear online four days before camp starts, and will not be there before that. If you find lice or nits please treat your child before coming to camp. Any camper found arriving at camp with lice will be subject to a \$100 treatment fee, will be quarantined in the health center, and may be sent home from camp.

Prescription Medications. If your child takes prescription medications, he/she must use CampRX. You can sign up at www.camprx.com. Medications must not be sent with your camper, unless they are required during the day of travel. Over the counter meds can be ordered through CampRX if your child takes them regularly, but most will be stocked at our health center.

Tee-shirt. You will be getting a brightly colored Wazi tee-shirt for your camper to wear while traveling on the first day of camp. All campers must wear this shirt, even if they are being dropped off. If the shirt is not a perfect fit (unless it's impossible to wear), please just have them wear it to camp, where we will exchange it for them. The shirt helps us identify campers when they travel. It is a free gift to you.

Parent Communicator - Please take a moment to sign up for our new and improved email and pictures system, "Parent Communicator": www.parentcommunicator.com/campwazyatah . You can view pictures of your campers at no charge, which we upload every day. For a fee, you can order prints, download pictures, etc., and send one-way emails to your campers. Emails are printed daily and delivered to campers in their cabins. It's a great system and you're going to love the daily pictures! For return mail, we will provide postcards and kids must write home at least once each week.
